# **Google Chrome**

## Windows:

- 1. In the address bar, type chrome://settings/content
- 2. On the Content settings screen, find the Flash Player listing. Check the status
- 3. Select Allow sites to run Flash, and then click Done

#### Mac OS:

- 1. In the address bar, type chrome://settings/content

## **Firefox**

### Windows:

- 1. In the address bar, type about:addons
- 2. Select Plugins
- 3. In the list of Add-ons, look for Shockwave Flash (another name for Flash Player) and check the status that appears to the right of the plug-in name
- 4. Select Always Activate
- 5. Close the dialog box

## Mac OS:

- 1. Choose Firefox > Tools > Add-ons
- 2. Select Plugins
- 3. In the list of Add-ons, look for Shockwave Flash (another name for Flash Player) and check the status that appears to the right of the plug-in name
- 4. Select Always Activate
- 5. Close the dialog box

# **Internet Explorer**

- 1. Click the Tools icon in the upper-right corner of Internet Explorer. (The icon looks like a gear)
- 2. In the pop-up menu that appears, click Manage Add-ons
- 3. In the dialog box that appears, select Toolbars and Extensions.In the list of Add-ons, look for "Shockwave Flash Object" (another name for Flash Player)
- 4. In the Status column, check to see whether Shockwave Flash Object is Disabled. If it is disabled, click the row for Shockwave Flash Object to highlight it
- 5. In the lower-right corner of the Manage Add-ons dialog box, click Enable
- 6. Close the Manage Add-ons dialog box
